A. School Wellness Policy for SY 2010-11

The Hawaii State DOE implementation of the Wellness Guidelines requires practice to be in place for the 2010-11 School Year. To that purpose Mililani Uka Parent Handbook and programs will include the following:

1. Teacher will provide adequate time and facilities for students to wash hands before snacks and meals.
2. Students will be provided with required minutes of weekly physical education by the PE teacher and homeroom teacher. Mililani Uka will not withhold physical activities as a punishment. Students will be encouraged to participate in moderate to vigorous activity during recess.
3. Students will be encouraged to eat a healthy breakfast, lunch, and snacks. Students will receive the required minutes of weekly nutrition education by the homeroom teacher.
4. Celebrations - Holidays will encourage healthy foods or non-food items.  
Birthdays encourage elimination of food treats.
5. Other School Activities will be adapted to meet USDA guidelines and State DOE Wellness Guidelines.

The SCC board discussed, voted and approved the new policy.
