V. Role Group Reports
A. ORT: Resource teachers have been busy with student assessment, Quest and Aims web testing. Additionally, the computer labs and library are setting up rooms from renovations. Mrs. Bagoyo expressed her gratitude for the volunteers, who are assisting to un-box the Library.
B. Administration:
1. Renovation: The Office, Cafeteria and Library were completed over the summer. There is a hold on additional classroom renovation until other areas are completed. Workers are currently painting exterior after school until about 12:30 a.m. Neighbors were approached prior to starting the night work and no complaints logged.
2. Average Yearly Progress Report: Results from the spring testing were shared. Mililani Uka had excellent participation of students and met those requirements. Overall reading scores improved by seven percent and Math by eleven percent. One student from the disadvantaged group missed by one point on the math so that the school missed that role by one percent. The school is appealing the scoring. Overall Uka was very pleased with the improvement and student scores and will continue to work with all students to meet the increased target numbers for 2011.
3. Birthday Celebration Policy- Wellness Policy was distributed with the revisions made from the May meeting as published in the current Parent Handbook.

Currently there will be no food distribution for birthday celebrations. The focus group will review the policy again based on current feed-back.

C. Hui - The Hui officers have been busy planning the Hui fundraisers and preparations for the Hui General Meeting held on Parent Orientation night (8/18/2010).

Monthly Jamba juice sales are planned using all fruit smoothies in the 8 ounce size for \$2.00. First sale is Thursday, August 19. First Hui Board meeting will be held on Thursday, August 12, 2010.

1. Good response from Kindergarten Parent Orientation on Monday, 8/9, 2010. Evaluations ranked 20 Agree, 30 strongly agreed, 1 disagreed that the night was a successful orientation,

2. Results of Raise a Reader Challenge from May showed that 262 students participated logging 172,369 minutes of the challenged 100,000 minutes.

3. A big thank you to all the volunteers and staff who have assisted in the library with un-boxing of books. Different staff members, parent & community volunteers have dropped by on a daily basis and will continue until all boxes are finished.
